It was decided to uphold the next meeting date as scheduled (Thursday 1 June), with further discussions to be had between Gavin and Arakwal Board members regarding meeting times.

2. Parking in Byron Bay

Gavin noted that the Arakwal Corporation pay \$800 per year for parking for 10 board members through a business permit, and would encourage Dean Rotumah to apply for the same. Gavin suggested any penalty notices are Dean's responsibility and that he should be paying for parking as the Arakwal do, he should not be exempt.

3. Past Committee members

The Committee acknowledged the work of Councillors Spooner and Richardson on this committee and thanked them for their contribution.
