We pleased to make application to the Local Traffic Committee for approval to conduct the 12th annual fundraising <u>Byron</u> <u>Bay Lighthouse Run</u> on Sunday 14th October 2018. *The 2018 event will operate on the same course and design as* 2017.

The Byron Bay Lighthouse Run is a fun run and walk raising money for charity. In 2018 the event is supporting Our Kids in Lismore and Samantha Bulmer.

Consultation with the community and local businesses is essential in the planning of the Lighthouse Run; together with our proposed partners including Fusion, Byron Bay Brewery, Beach Café, Reindeer Riot, NXsports, Byron Hire, and Byron Shire Council, we will work to deliver a valuable economic and socially responsible project with perennial returns for stakeholders and our charitable partners.


