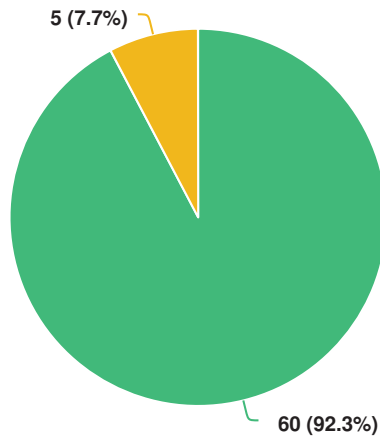

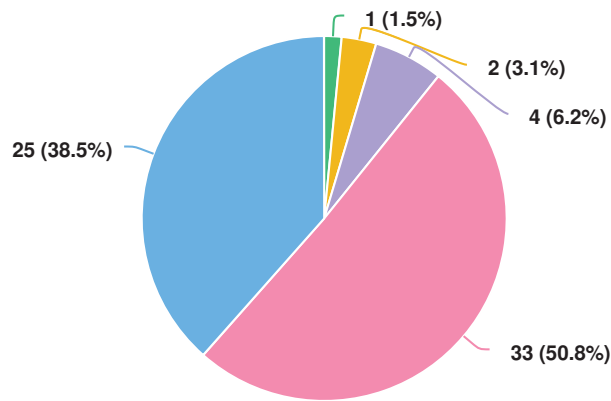

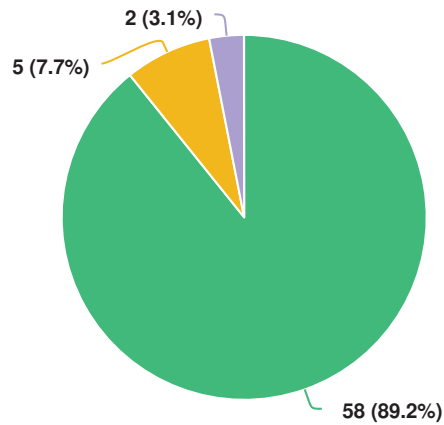
Q2 | What is your age group?

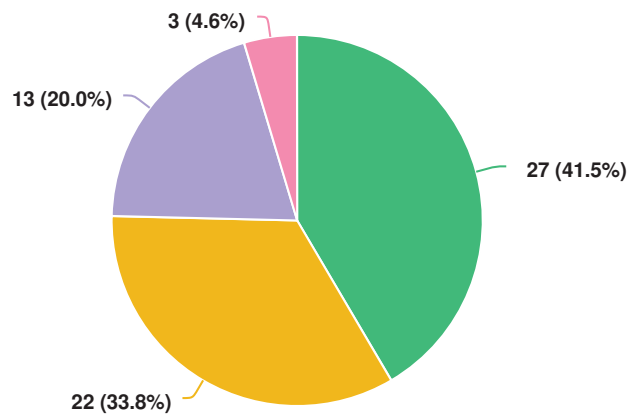

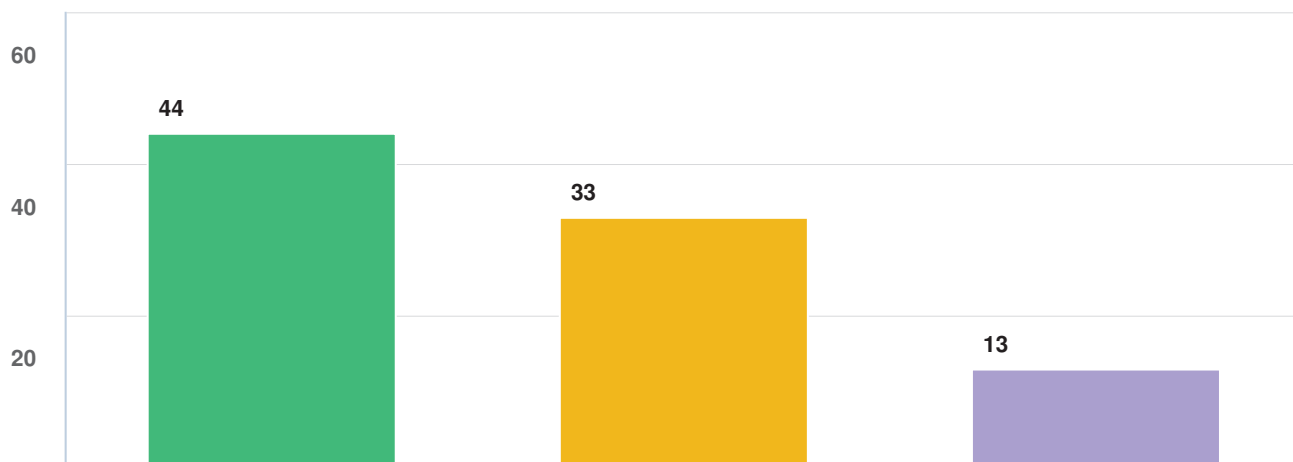

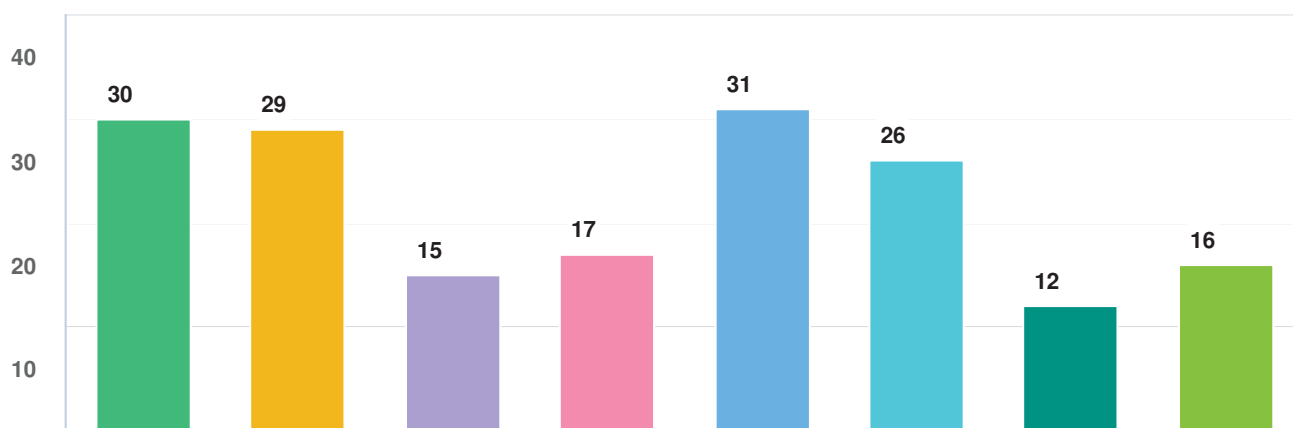

Q10 Do you support the proposed concept plan?

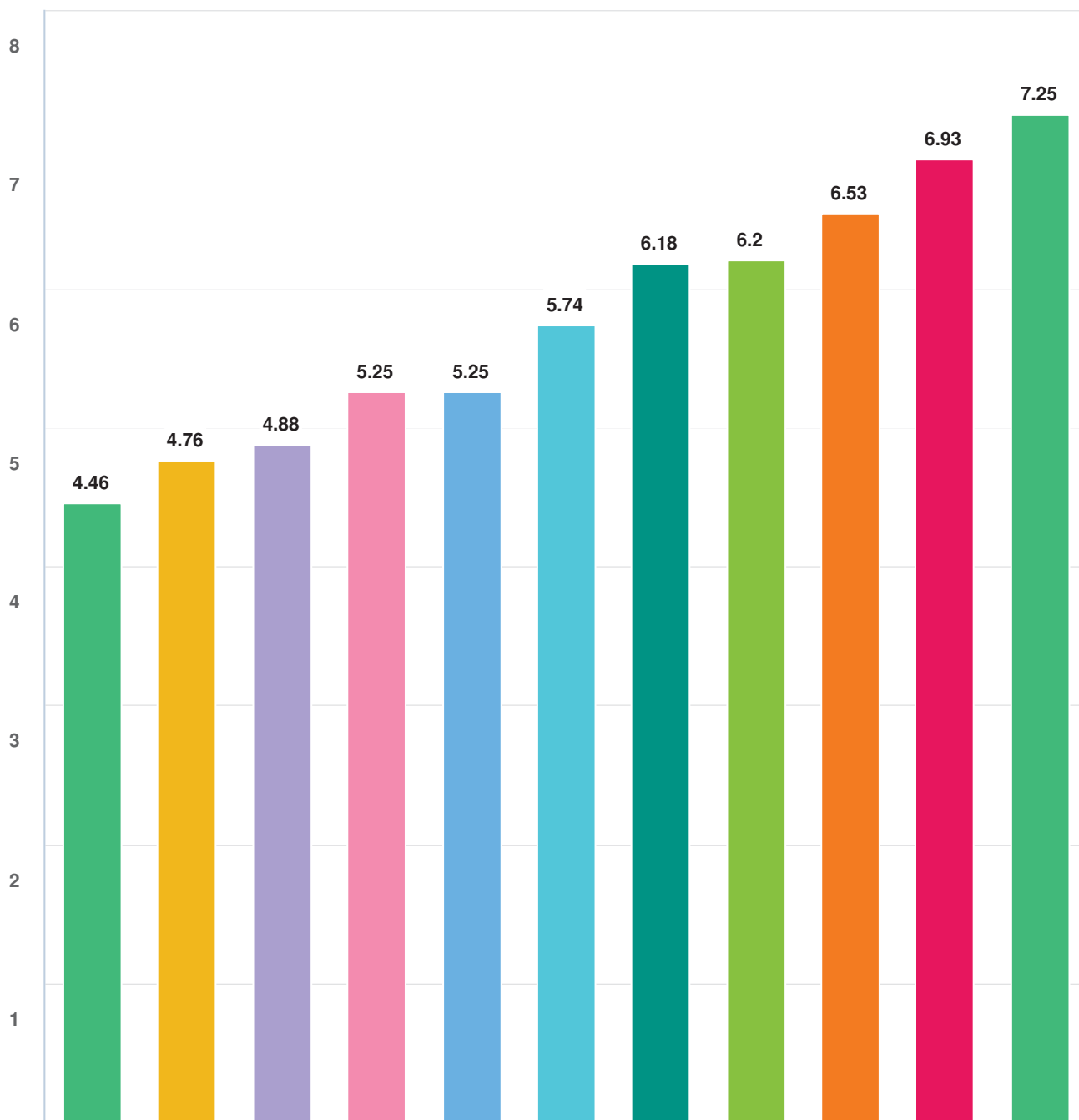
