



As per above, it is a heavily used location for school bus drop offs and pick ups, with no bus shelter and little to no signage. The bus stop area is just dirt, with no clearly defined sealed area where buses are meant to stop, they just drive onto the dirt. It is also quite a dangerous intersection as it is an 80km/h zone here with no turning lanes into Rifle Range Rd from Bangalow Rd. When the buses are there it creates an issue for vehicles pulling out of Rifle Range Rd, heading towards Lismore, as their line of sight for oncoming traffic is significantly reduced. This whole strip along Bangalow Rd, west of the town centre, is not very friendly for buses or pedestrians.

A new bus stop for all buses at the cnr of Byron Bay Road & Old Ballina Road Bangalow. The fast growing nature of this part of town makes it no longer considered to be out of town. A well considered design that would make sure it is out of flood reach, would enable it to be the safest and accessible site for a bus interchange in the village of Bangalow. A one a way in (south end) and one way out (north end) traffic design would make it much safer. An all weather shelter with low level solar lighting would be essential, plus a bike rack, a water station, and bins. It would be an advantage here to have car parking spaces and to locate an area for long vehicle parking such as caravans, motorhomes and small trucks with trailers. There are very few spaces

available in the village for caravans and long vehicles. A bus interchange at this site would take the bus traffic off Deacon Street making this street much safer. With the buses no longer on Deacon street and the great wide footpath eventually going past this site, makes this site within cycle and walking distance. This site is one of the few options available in Bangalow for a bus stop. Another site for a bus stop is on the west side of Bangalow opposite the old Readings store, along this wide area. This whole area could also be opened up for parking spaces, a much needed asset for the village. It also has the potential for a walking path on the railway corridor, this would enable school children/people to cycle or walk to the bus stop and town centre. It would require a shelter with low level solar lighting, bike rack, bins and a water station would be an advantage. The disadvantage here, as I see it, is that there is no room for buses to turn around, or to safely stop for picking up or putting down passengers when travelling west. It would only cater for people travelling from west to east, west to north, west to south.




