- Assisted Andrew Cameron with the grant application and budgeting for BSC's Smart Farms Small Grants Round 2 application which was successful.
- 18th December meeting with Madeline Pratt from BSC re current projects
- 15th January meeting with BSC Chloe, Jo, Karen, Pete and Sharyn re Biodiversity projects.
- 30th January met with Dave from BSC regen team at Yallakool with the group to walk over the site and discuss what the regen team will now maintain they will do all the spraying on the site, freeing up the group to move into the Devine's hill lookout reserve.
- 4th February meeting with BSC Joanne McMurtry and Shannon McKelvey re volunteering council are looking at reviewing their policy around volunteers and how they can support them better. Suggested that help for first aid training, chem cert training etc would be good. They suggested also that traffic control may be possible.
- 11th February meeting with BSC and Nigel from Ecosure who is contracted to work on the Biodiversity conservation Strategy talking about priorities and simplifying objectives.
