LANDCARE GROUPS

- 26 BVL locality groups 17 working on council owned land

- National Landcare Program Environmental Small Grants in Yallakool Reserve Educational signs are done and waiting to be installed in the reserve. Rochelle Meredith has been working with the group to train them on weed control techniques esp Ipomea.

FUNDING

 Rous County Council Community Weeds Project submitted EOI for \$18,333 for a 1 year project for ONGROUND works to do Asparagus, Bitou and Glory Lilly weed biosecurity work on council land at Main Beach Byron, Cavanbah dunes and Suffolk Park Dunes. Working with Green and Clean Awareness Team and Suffolk Park Dunecare, with inkind from Bush Regen team – details of work were decided on with David Filipczyk.
