Further to the email dated 12 July I received from you regarding the renaming a part of Granuaille Crescent, Bangalow.

I would like to offer a suggestion for the name change as offered in this letter.

That whole block at the top of the hill out to St Helena Ridge, and down to Bangalow, that now has been subdivided was once owned by a gentleman by the name of James Noble. James Noble built the house that I now live in, called Jelbon Leigh. Jelbon Leigh is a significant, local architectural landmark and is heritage listed.

I would like to propose the name of **Noble Lane/Road/Street/Crescent** or **Jelbon Lane/Road/Street/Crescent** as a tribute to a pioneering settler/family, that was directly associated with that exact area of Bangalow, who ended up being quite a local character from what I have been led to believe by the Bangalow Historical Society, they even have a picture of him skipping down the main street of Bangalow hanging on their wall! James Noble was obviously instrumental in the early days of the establishment of Bangalow Township, so I feel it would be appropriate to honour his contribution to the area this way.
