G'day Andrew

Thank you for making contact with me on this issue.

As discussed in our phone conversation on Wednesday, i have worked at the gated community (Cyprus) in Byron Bay on a number of different occasions, maintaining all their tree's. The majority of the work are on Cyprus Pines (Coastal Callitris Pine) due the high number growing on the property. I would say that 85% of the tree population on the property would be Cyprus Pine.

In my experience working at Cyprus, i have not come across any adverse reactions from the Coastal Callitris Pine growing adjacent to the load cell construction to the best of my knowledge. as explained in our phone conversation, i am a qualified Certificate 3 arborist, so i can not give a tree report that would be of any merit. that said i do have an understanding of tree structure and how they react in different environments. In the case of the load cell construction affecting the Cyprus Pines, i would say that it would have little to no affect to the best of my knowledge.

If you require a second independent tree report, from a well educated certificate 5 consulting arborist i would highly recommend Kasha Annesley. He is based in Lismore and would be of great assistance in your situation.

I will Cc Kasha in on this email for future reference if he is needed.
