New Brighton Parking Improvements

The purpose of this letter is to provide an update on Council’s investigations into parking improvements at New Brighton and to inform you about two drop-in sessions we are holding specifically related to public parking in the New Brighton area.

Council has been looking at parking in the area for several years after requests from the community and Councillors.

There is no doubt that parking at New Brighton is difficult, and this is due to a number of reasons:

- Lack of public space.
- Narrow roads and housing development that were not designed to cater for beach-goers and large numbers of visitors.
- Sensitive beach and bush environments.

As part of our investigations, we have looked at the potential for parking improvements in several locations and are proposing some changes. We are interested in hearing what you think about these proposals.
