I am thinking of joining the ANF(Australian naturist federation), if I do, i would like to suggest that any nudist that can use any part of the beach to have an ANF armband with a cost.

I believe if reopening the beach so its more than 800m, have more police patrolling/controlling.

Spending a day at the beach and going for a walk, nudists only got 800m of walking distance, its too short.

Nudists are not causings any problems if just walking along the beach, its only happening in the dunes.

I can be honest to say that nudity is both natural and sexual but its the sex preditors who are not really nudists are the problem.
