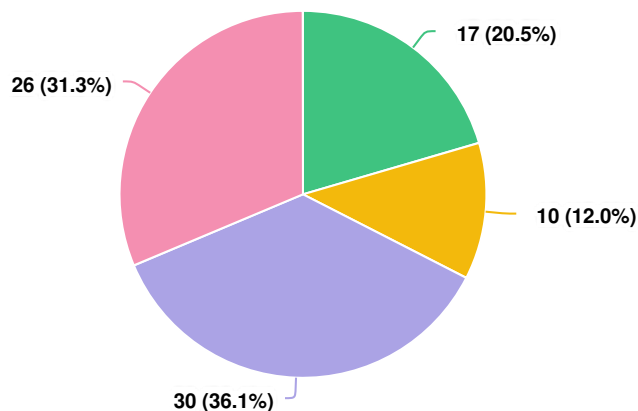

Q1 How often do you visit the Sandhills Estate now?

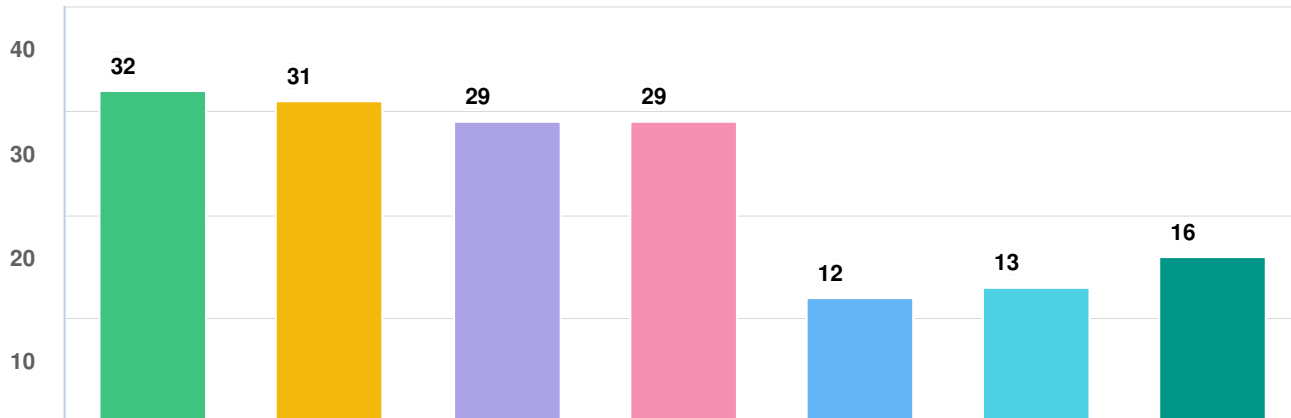

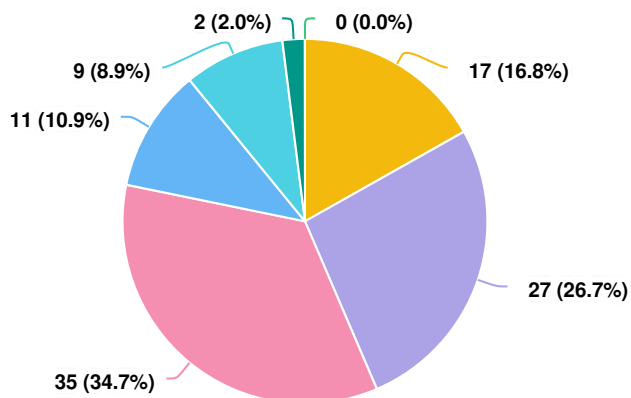
