

SHIRE COUNCIL 2023 Grants (FY 2022-2023)

The following provides an overview of the 2023 grants program.

During the financial year 2023, Council applied for 57 grants of which:

- · 31 applications were awarded funding
- 7 unsuccessful
- 1 withdrawn
- 18 awaiting determination.

The total value of the grant funding awarded in FY 2023 was approximately **\$17.6** million with a total project value **\$18.1** million.

At the end of 2023, Council had 74 active grants; that is, projects that are still being completed. The 74 active grants includes programs that consist of multiple projects. As at 30 June 2023, grant funded projects had a total project value of approximately \$87 million, of which **\$74.6 million was grant funded**.

A summary of years 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 has been included.

The grant funding is recorded in the year the funding is awarded; that is, the funding agreement was executed. The funding is dispersed across the years according to project progress, therefore, the yearly totals will not match Council's financial annual report.

This report does NOT include the Essential Public Asset Restoration (EPAR) projects under the AGRN1012 natural disaster program (February/March flooding events).

This report is subject to change eg. acquittal, funding amount varies, projects withdrawn. If you have problems viewing this report, please contact Council for an accessible version.

Glossary

Grant Status

Active - project that has been awarded funding and is in progress of being delivered.

Unsuccessful - projects that were NOT awarded grant funding.

Submitted - projects that are waiting determination, that is successful or unsuccessful.

Withdrawn - grant application withdrawn by staff from the funding program.

Acquitted - project that has been awarded funding and has been completed.

Grant type

Competitive - funding awarded under a competitive process and required a funding application.

Non-competitive - funding that was allocated to Council. No application required.

Disaster competitive - funding awarded as a result of a natural disaster and was assessed via a competitive process.

Disaster non-competitive - funding awarded as a result of a natural disaster and was NOT assessed under a competitive process.

Directorate

Council has three main <u>directorates</u> including:

Infrastructure Services (IS) - roads, major projects, drainage, water, utilities, resource recovery, sporting facilities, parks, community buildings.

Sustainable Environment and Economy - land use planning, coastal, biodiversity, sustainability, place activation, events, public and environmental services.

Corporate and Community Services - finance, rates, governance, customer service, records management, IT, library services, community development and projects.

Funding sources

Total Project \$ – total cost of the project at the time of the application, including all funding sources

Grant \$ - grant funding amount awarded


Council \$ - amount Council has contributed towards the project at the time of application

Council in-kind \$ - staff wages associated with the grant that are considered a co-contribution

Other \$ - other external funding sources eg another grant or external in-kind






