



Development Consent

Section 4.38 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979

The Independent Planning Commission (the Commission), as the declared consent authority under clause 8A of the State Environmental Planning Policy (State and Regional Development) 2011 and section 4.5(a) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979, approves the development application referred to in Schedule 1, subject to the conditions in Schedule 2.

These conditions are required to:

- · prevent, minimise, or offset adverse environmental impacts;
- set standards and performance measures for acceptable environmental performance;
- require regular monitoring and reporting; and
- · provide for the ongoing environmental management of the development

Maximum Size and Frequency of Outdoor Events

A8. Subject to the Planning Secretary's approval for the progressive increase of the large events in Condition D9, the Applicant must comply with the maximum sizes and frequencies of outdoor events outlined in Table 1.

"It was so noticeable that the capacity had increased ... we were popping squats because the lines for the toilets were so long," she said. She said after waiting 4.5 hours to get a bus back to her accommodation on Saturday night, she did not get into bed until 6:30am on Sunday and decided not to return for the third day of the festival.

"We were calling out for someone to bring us water, [but were] completely ignored," Ms Hamdorf said.

"One guy near me fainted and we were calling out for a medic ... and there was nobody.

Lismore News:

"There was a lot of confusion," van Lier said. "A lot of people were getting out of their cars and just walking. Girls trying to find toilets. People trying to find food.

"People were just giving up and trying to sleep in their cars.

"There was no word from the festival. They weren't posting much and not talking about what would happen and what people should do."
