





Adam is one of the people who is impacted by this problem, so he decided to start a petition, requiring over 1,000 signatures, to be presented to the Byron Shire Council on Thursday. In only five days, with support from his carers,, Adam has exceeded the goal of 1,000 signatures.




All this was started by Adams' initiative, along with his mum telling him to stop complaining about the lack of public transport and do something to make a change.


















