Planning proposal request for Gateway Byron Shire State Environmental Planning Policy No 70 Affordable Housing (Revised Schemes) - DPIE reference PP-2021-7395

Thank you for the opportunity to clarify on the matter of 11 April 2019 Council resolution (19-152) to prepare an affordable housing contribution scheme and its associated local environmental plan amendment. Table 1 below sets out how this resolution has been progressed. It shows the submission of the planning proposal is authorised under this resolution and supported by subsequent Council resolutions.
