I wish to commend the Surf Club for the great work they have done and do, and their well considered plans for a new facility to support that. I've been a twice daily user of the 400 metre Off Leash Dog Area on the beach and the Surf Club lawn for some seven years, am 79, and write from my own self interest and that of the good friends I have made in so doing - even though my great four footed friend C J has departed. I've appreciated the almost level access on the southern side of the Club House to the pathway to the beach (and voluntarily try to clean and maintain the public shower base and surround and make sure dog "poo" bags are on hand there). However in looking a the Club's plans I note that the bigger Clubhouse will extend right across to that southern side of the land, which rises notably south and eastward along the fence line right there - where it seems the new Clubhouse will extend to. I write to plead the case for the many older folk such as I (who keep much healthier and happier by bringing their four footed companions to the beach) and for the families with a dog and small children who also come. Plead for what? To have provision made for a similarly level smooth access, as direct as possible, from the carpark to the end of the sole track direct from there to the off leash dog exercise part of of the beach. It seems from the plans submitted that this would require some excavation of the vegetated dune and seeding or turfing of a suitable nature. In closing I would mention that the oldest daily user of the existing open access I write of had his 90th birthday during the year, and that many of our four footed companions whose ageing rate exceeds our own by a factor of about 7, already move slowly beside us. Mothers, Fathers and siblings etc with toddlers likewise. So - this submission to say Thankyou to the Club, and if what I write has not already been factored in to plans to ask that it become part of the landscaping/public benefit and access considerations.
